MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION
OF

Centers of Excellence for Advance Research

1. Name of Society

The name of society shall be :

"Centers of Excellence for Advanced Research"

2. Registered office :

The Registered office of the Society shall be situated in the Union Territory of Delhi. At present it is situated at the following address:

F-12, Pushpanjali Farms
Bijwasan, New Delhi - 110061

3. Working Area : All over Delhi.

4. Aims and Objective

- a. To undertake scientific research in any field including medical, health care, environment, agriculture, epidemiology, pathology, treatment of various diseases including cancer with special emphasis on the techniques for prevention, detection therapy and rehabilitation of patients.
- b. To initiate projects for development of the Scientific Research Centers supported by Laboratories, Operation Theatres, Radio Therapy Units, Chemo Therapy units, Rehabilitation Centers, Yoga Ashrams and Natural Therapy Centers for carrying out Scientific Research and development in innovation of medical and surgical techniques.
- c. To retain and/or employ skilled professional research scholars or medical advisers and other stall and workers in connection with the objects of the society and to pay thereof such fees or remuneration as may be thought expedient.
- d. To do all such other deeds and things either alone or in conjunction with others as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects stated herein or any of them.
- e. To receive and maintain a fund or funds and to administer and apply the income and principal thereof for the furtherance of the objects of the society.
- f. To accept contributions, grants aids and donations in cash and or kind from individuals, Joint Stock Companies Firms, Trusts, and Foundations, State and Central Government or any other bodies, national and international by the Society for the capital expenses as well as to form income to meet recurring and incidental expenses to meet the aims and objects of the Society.

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- g. To manage sell transfer, let-out by way of lease license or otherwise dispose off or deal with the assets/properties of any kind both moveable and immovable belonging to the Society.
- h. To enter into any agreement or arrangement with any other Trust/Society, Foundation or any other party having any legal entity or any individual for the purposes of the Society.
- i. The surplus funds of the society, if any, will be invested as per the provisions of Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as specified at the relevant time or as may be permitted from time to time by the Government of India.
- j. All the income, earnings and assets including moveable and immovable properties of the society shall be utilized solely towards the achievement and carrying out of its aims and objects as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no person or entity including the past or present members of the society or any office bearer shall be entitled to any share in any profit, earnings or income of the society and shall also not have any claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the society by virtue of the membership of the society.

All the incomes, earnings, moveable immovable -properties, of the Society shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only as set forth in the Memorandum of Association and no profit on thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present or past Members of the Society or to any person claiming through anyone or more of the present members. No member of the Society shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the Society or make any profits whatsoever by virtue of this membership.



RULES AND REGULATIONS.

OF

NAME OF THE SOCIETY

The name of the Society shall be "Centers of Excellence for Advanced Research"

1. Objects :

The objects of the Society shall include the several objects expressed in the Memorandum of Association of the Society.

2. Membership :

a. The membership of the Society is voluntary and open to all individuals provided he/ she must be at-least of 18 years of age and shall abide by its rules and regulations. Any Corporate Body, Firm, Trust, Foundation, Society or Association will also be entitled to become a member of the Society.

(aa) Companies. Firms and other Corporate Bodies shall be entitled to nominate one representative.

(aaa) The Board of Governors at their sole discretion may grant the status of a "Patron Member" to an existing member subject to provisions of rule 3 (b). A Patron Member will also be entitled to nominate one representative for every Rs. One Lac of contribution made by him/her/it for realization of the objects of the Society. Each representative have one vote on matters submitted to vote members.

b. The founder members shall be those who are signatories to the Memorandum of Association.

c. A person shall have the rights and privileges of a member of the Society only if after having been admitted by the Board of Governors as aforesaid or/he/she/it has paid an admission fee and a subscription and has signed the roll or list of members thereof and shall continue to have such rights and privileges until he/she/it ceases to be a member by virtue of these Rules and Regulation or by resigning from membership by filing resignation with the Society

d. Such member shall be entitled to one vote subject to clause 2(aaa) above on each matter submitted to the vote of the members.

e. The membership in the Society is not transferable.

f. Membership will be as Ordinary Member, Patron Member and Honorary Member.

g. The Board of Governors shall be competent to nominate any person eminent in any known field connected with the objects of the Society as Honorary Member of the Society or as an Honorary Member of the Board of Governors of the Society.



3. Method to become a Member.

- a. Persons as referred to in Rule 2 (a) above desiring to enroll themselves as Members shall apply for membership to the President of the Society on the prescribed form. An applicant may be enrolled as a member provided his /her/its application is approved by the Board of Governors as also by the Society by at-least three fourth majority of the total voting strength of all Members of the Society whether present in the Meeting or not.
- b. The Board of Governors may at its sole discretion grant the status of Patron Member "to an existing member whose association is considered by the Board to be beneficial to the society, provided such Member has also made a minimum Contribution of Rs. One Crore for furthering the objects of the Society, such sum may have been paid in one lump sum or over the years. No Member can claim the said status of a "Patron Member" as of right and the decision of the Board of Governors in this behalf shall be final and binding on all concerned. However, such Member after the grant of status of a "Patron Member" shall continue to be liable to pay the annual subscription fee as herein provided in addition to the contribution referred to above.

4. Subscription :

Every member shall have to pay the admission fee, yearly subscription, life membership subscription to start with as mentioned hereunder and later on as may be decided by the Board of Governors of the Society from time to time.

4.1 Founder Members –



Admission Fee will be Rs. Ten Thousands and annual subscription Rs. Three Thousand in case of individuals and Rs. Fifty Thousands and Fifteen Thousands for Corporate member respectively.

4.2 Ordinary Membership

The admission fee will be Rs. Ten Thousand and annual subscription will be Rs. Three Thousand payable in advance.

4.3 Corporate Membership

The admission fee for any Corporation, Trust, Foundation, or any other Body shall be Rs. One Lakh and annual subscription will be Rs. Fifteen Thousand, payable in advance.



44 Honorary Membership

There will be no Fee or subscription for persons nominated by the Board of Governors for Honorary Membership as per Rule 2 (g).

5. Cessation of Membership

A member shall cease to be a member of the Society in the following events:-

- (a) If the member resigns by giving one month's notice.
- (b) If the member is adjudged insolvent or of unsound mind or convicted of an offence, which in the opinion of the Board of Governors involves moral turpitude
- (c) If the member fails to pay subscription and/or any other sum due to the Society for a period of six consecutive months after three notices have been given to the Member by the Society.
- (d) If the member works against the spirit of the Society, its objects and rules and regulations.
- (e) If the member dies.
- (f) If the member activities are harmful and/or prejudicial to the interest of the Society.
- (g) The membership of any person may be terminated at any time by the Board of Governors as also by the Society by at-least 2/3rd majority of the total voting strength of all the members of the Society whether present in the meeting or not.

6. Re-admission :

A member, who has ceased to be a member, shall be eligible for re-admission to membership on a fresh application and payment of fees subject to the provisions of Rule 3 hereof

7. Membership Register:-

The Society shall keep a register of all its members containing their names, addresses, occupations, designations & phone nos. The Register shall be up-to-dated from time to time. The register shall be open to inspection by any member at the office of the Society during the normal working hours provided he/she must have obtained the written permission of the president of the Society.



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8. Member's Rights and Privileges:

Every member duly enrolled as a member shall enjoy all rights and privileges assured by the constitution of the society and the rules framed herein.

9. General Body:

All members enrolled as a member under clauses 2 supra shall form the General Body of the Society.

10. Powers and Duties of the General Body:

The General Body shall exercise general supervision over the working of the Society.

a) Notwithstanding the exercise generality of the powers vested in the General Body of the Society, all contracts, liabilities debts or any other matters involving monetary value exceeding Rs. 100 Lakhs in each specific case or any matter involving a substantial issue, deemed as such by the Board of Governors, shall be subject to the approval of the General Body.

11. Annual General Meeting:


An Annual General Meeting of the Members shall be held once in a year for the purpose of passing annual accounts and for transacting any other business as may come before the Meeting at the Registered office of the Society unless otherwise determined by the Board of Governors.

12. Special Meeting:

Special meeting may be called either by the President of the Board of Governors or by not less than two-third of the members having voting rights. Such meeting shall be held at the Registered Office of the Society or at such other place as may be notified by the President Secretary.

13. Notice :

Written or printed notice stating the place, day and hour of any meeting shall be delivered either personally or by post to each member entitled to vote at such meeting, not less than ten days before the day of such meeting or by at the direction of the President or the Secretary calling the meeting. In case of a special meeting is required by statute or by these Rules, the purpose for which the meeting is called shall be stated in the notice. The notice of any meeting, if sent by post, shall be deemed to have been delivered when deposited in the Post Office with pre-paid post and addressed to the Members at the addresses appearing in the book of the Society.



14. Quorum and Vote :

Quorum for the General Body meeting will be 50% of the total members and the decision shall be taken by majority vote. The President shall have a casting vote in case of tie.

15. Adjourned Meeting :

If within half an hour of the time fixed for the meeting, the quorum is not present, the meeting shall stand adjourned and shall be held again as determined by the members present.

16. Board of Governors :

The affairs of the Society shall be managed by the Board of Governors of the Society to be elected by the General Body of the Society by secret ballot or by raising hands every five years. The Board of Governors shall consist of not less than three members and not more than seven members including office bearers and the composition will be President, Vice President, Secretary-cum Treasurer and members to make a total of seven.

(a) The Board of Governors shall consist of not less than three members and not more than seven member including President, Vice President, Secretary –cum- Treasurer.

(b) Two third of total number of the Board of Governors of the Society shall be subject to retirement by rotation and will be eligible for re-election.

~~Election~~ (c) President, Vice President Secretary cum Treasure shall not be subject to retirement by rotation and will hold office for full term of 5 years and will be eligible for reappointment to the Board of Governors on completion of each term of five years.

(d) One third of the total number of Governors who are liable to retire by rotation shall retire every year but will be eligible for re-election.

(e) Board of Governors shall have power to nominate persons of eminence in the field of area of research or any member of the society to the Board of Governors who shall be liable to retire by rotation also. The maximum number of such nominees should not exceed three at any point of time.

17. Powers and functions of the Board of Governors

The Board of Governors shall meet at-least once in in three months to transact such business in connection with the management of the Society as may be considered expedient and/ or necessary for which requisite agenda shall be circulated to the members of the Board at-least seven days in advance of the meeting.

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
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Without limiting the general powers of the Board of Governors to manage the affairs of the Society for attainment of its objects, the Board of Governors shall also have the powers subject to the provisions of Rules 10 and 10 A:-

- a) to convert any property moveable and/or immovable or any part of the Society's Fund into cash by selling or otherwise disposing of the same and thereafter re-invest the same in any security, properties, moveable or immovable or otherwise
- b) to grant, convey, transfer, mortgage, charge, let out, gift, settle or otherwise deal with any immovable property belonging to the Society for the purpose of the Society in such a manner and on such terms as the Board of Governors may in their absolute discretion, deem fit.
- c) to invest any surplus funds not needed for immediate scientific research work by the institute only in deposits of Nationalized Banks or Government Securities or such other public investments approved specifically by the Authority and as per the provisions of section 11(5) of the Income tax Act ,1961.
- d) to operate or raise 'moneys or secure the payment of any moneys borrowed for the purposes of the Society by pledge, hypothecation, charge or mortgage of whole or any part of moveable or immovable properties comprised in the Society's Fund on such terms of Governors may in their absolute discretion as they think proper.
- e) to sell by public auction or private contractor exchange, gift or transfer or assign or grant, lease or sub lease for any terms however long or otherwise dispose of or permit to be used at such rent, compensation or fee all or any part of the Society's fund including movable and immovable properties comprised therein an on such terms and conditions relating to title or otherwise and in all respects as they may think proper and to rescind or vary and contract for sale, mortgage, transfer, gift assignment, lease or other disposition and to resell the same or enter into a fresh contract for sale, exchange, transfer, assignment, gift, lease or other disposition with any person.
- f) The persons whose names and addresses are given hereunder shall be the founder Members of the Society until the first meeting of the original and other Members of the Society is convened and election of the Members for the Board of Governors takes place. The original Members shall be deemed to be the Board of Governors until the new Board of Governors is duly elected and installed by the Members. The Board of Governors thus elected shall be responsible for the management and affairs of the Society as required U/s 2 of the Societies Registration Act of 1860 (Punjab Amendment Act of 1957) as extended to the Union Territory of Delhi

18. Meeting & Quorum :

The Board of Governors may meet from time to time as they may deem fit for which a notice of at-least seven days shall be given by the Secretary. Any urgent meeting can be called on a notice of 24 hours with the approval of the President. 50% of the total members shall form the quorum, on the absence of the quorum the meeting shall stand



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adjourned and shall be held again as determined by the members present. This shall be circulated by the Secretary to the members. A resolution may be passed by circulation among the Governors who are in India and if a majority expresses their opinion in favour of it, a resolution so passed shall be as valid as if it was passed at a duly held Board meeting.

19. Vacancies .

Any vacancy occurring in the Board of Governors shall be filled by the Board of Governors and the Governor so elected to fill the vacancy shall continue as such Governor during the unexpired term of the predecessor-in-office. The existence of any such vacancy shall not invalidate the decisions; actions taken by the rest of the Members of the Board of Governors.

20. Power and functions of office bearers

President: The post of the President Shall be honorary and elected by the Board of Governors out of their own members for a term of five years but eligible for re-election. The affairs of the Society shall be managed by the President of the Society under the control and direction of the Board. All papers documents and deeds of the Society shall be signed by the President in the name of Society and all acts and deeds done by the President by virtue of the Rules and Regulations shall be binding on the Board of Governors and the Society. The President shall invariably preside over all the meetings of Board of Governors and of the General Body. In case of equality of votes, the President can exercise a casting vote.



Vice-President : The post of the Vice President, Treasurer cum Secretary shall be honorary and elected by the Board of Governors out of their own members for a term of five years but eligible for re-election. If for any reason, the President neglects or is otherwise unable to discharge his/her functions as such, the Vice President shall be responsible for discharge of all the responsibilities and exercise all powers as that of the President.

Secretary cum Treasurer :

The Secretary shall be responsible for convening meetings, maintenance of minutes, correspondence, membership register and matters assigned to him/her by the Board or Governors or the President.

The Treasurer shall be responsible for the collection of subscription, maintenance of records and accounts and pay the bills add expenses after getting the approval of the President.

In the absence of the President or in the event of his/ her inability or refusal to act, the Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President and when so acting shall have all the powers and be subject to all the restrictions upon the President. The Vice-President shall perform such duties as from time to time may be assigned to him/her by



the President or by the Board of Governors. In the absence of or in the event of inability or refusal to act by the President and/or Vice-President and/or Treasurer and/or Secretary the Board of Governors may authorize any one or their own member to discharge the functions of all or any of the officers aforesaid.

21. The Society shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Members of Board of Governors and save them harmless against any claim, Costs, charges, expenses, losses or damages or against any proceedings against the Members of Board of Governors for any bona fide act or any bona fide omission on their part in the discharge of their obligation except any liability on account of willful neglect or willful default or misappropriation by some dishonest act relating to the Society's Fund.

The members of Board of Governors may reimburse themselves and pay and discharge out of the Society's funds or moneys in their hand all expenses incurred for the purposes of the society. It is expressly agreed and declared that the Members of Board Governors shall be entitled to be paid their actual, travelling, boarding, lodging and other expenses which may be incurred by them in the performance of their duties including all expenses for the attendance of their meetings.

If any member of the Board of Governors shall be a lawyer, accountant, medical, practitioner, architect, engineer or a person carrying on any other profession, vocation or business he/she or his/her firm shall be entitled to charge for his/her of their normal professional services as agreed by the majority of Governors.

22. Committee :

The Board of Governors by resolution adopted by a majority of the Governors in office may designate one or more Committee each of which shall consist of one or more Governors and to the extent provided in the said resolution, shall have and exercise the authority of the Board of Governors in the management of the Society but the designation of such Committee and the delegation of authority thereto shall not operate to relieve the Board or any individual Member of any responsibility imposed upon it or him by law. In particular there may be constituted an Advisory Committee by the Board of Governors for the purpose of advising the Society on its scientific and technical affairs. The members of Such Advisory Committee may or may not be the Members of the Society and may consist of persons within or outside India and shall consist of men eminent in the field of oncology and of science in general. It may also consist of a Legal Adviser if the Board of Governors so decide. The Advisory Board shall, once constituted continue for a period of two years unless the Board by a Resolution adopted by a majority of the Governors present at the meeting at which a quorum is present resolve otherwise. Except in case of the advisory Committee each member of the Committee shall continue unless his/her successor is appointed or the Board of Governors decide.

Each Committee may appoint one of members as its Chair person. Vacancies in the Membership of the Committee may be filled by appointments made on the same manner as provided in the case of the original appointments. The Board of Governors

designating a Committee may provide as to what number shall constitute a quorum and the act of majority of the members present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Committee. Each Committee may adopt rules for its own governance not inconsistent with these rules and regulations or with rules adopted by the Board of Governors.

The Board of Governors will constitute an Advisory committee comprising persons of eminence from the Fields of medicine, science, research and such other fields whose contribution and advice will be conducive and beneficial to the attainment of the objects of the Society. The tenure of the said Advisory committee shall be two years. One of members of the Governing Body may be designated also to be a member of the said Advisory Committee.

23. Contracts and Funds

All cheques, draft or other orders for the payment of money or notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of society shall be signed by the President of the society or in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolutions of the Board of Governors of the Society. No part of the Society's fund or the income thereof shall incur to the benefit of any Governor, Office or Member of the Society. The Board of Governors may authorize any officer or officer's agent or agents of the Society in addition to the officers so authorized by these rules to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Society and such authority may be general or confined to specific instance.

24. Books and Records:


The Society shall keep correct and completed books and records of the association and have them audited by a Chartered Accountant and shall also keep minutes of the proceeding of its Members and Board of Governors, and shall keep them at the registered office or principal office giving the names and addresses of the members entitled to vote.

25. Amendment to Rules :

The Board of Governor's may make any changes in these Rules, if considered necessary and or expedient.

26. Financial Years:

The Financial accounts for the first year shall close as on 31st March 2019 and thereafter the accounting year of the Society shall be from 1st April to 31st March each year.



27. Audit of Accounts :

The general Body shall appoint a firm of Chartered Accountant as Auditor, who shall audit the accounts of the Society each year, before the Annual General Body Meeting.

28. Opening of Bank Account :

All funds of the Society shall be kept in its account with any scheduled banks and such accounts shall be operated by such office bearers/employees of the Society as may be decided from time to time by resolution of the Board of Governors.

29. Funds :

The funds of the Society shall consist of admission fee, subscription, contribution, donations, grants and aid etc.

30. Tenure of the Board of the Governors :

The Tenure of the Board of the Governors shall be five years.

31. Necessary Provisions of the S. R. Act, of 1860.

ANNUAL LIST

Society shall file a list of members of its Board of Governors every year in the office of the Registrar of Societies as per Sec. 4 of the S.12 Act of 1860.


Society may sue or be sued in the name of the President as per Sec. 6 of Societies Registration Act of 1860.

In the event of dissolution of the society ,the entire society funds shall be realized and first be used for payment of liabilities of the society .The assets left after meeting all such liabilities of the society shall be disbursed after obtaining the prior permission of the Commissioner of Income tax (Exemption), New Delhi or any other authority specified for this purpose, to any other trust/society having similar objects and which is registered u/s 12AA of the Income tax Act ,1961. In no circumstances it shall be distributed in any manner, to any member of the society or their relatives or any other related party.







32. Applicability Clause :-

All the provisions of the Societies Registration Act , XXI of 1860 (Punjab Amendment Act of 1957) as per extended to the Union Territory of Delhi shall apply to the Society".


